**Construction worker killed at the KVMRT construction site**

**KUALA LUMPUR, (24 May 2015):** MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd (MGKT), the main contractor for the Klang Valley Mass Rapid Transit (KVMRT) underground package regrets to inform that there has been a fatality involving a Bangladeshi worker at the Tun Razak Exchange MRT underground construction site.

The worker, identified as Safikul, aged 28, was dismantling the temporary structure which was used for slab work with a group of other workers when it gave way and collapsed at 1.15am.

Saifikul, a worker of SP Mega Sdn Bhd, the sub-contractor engaged to carry out Reinforced Concrete works, was trapped beneath the debris while the other workers escaped unhurt. Safikul was rushed to Hospital Kuala Lumpur and succumbed to his injuries.

The sub-contractor SP Mega Sdn Bhd, is making arrangements to inform the Bangladesh High Commission to send the body back once the post-mortem is completed and the body is released by the Hospital.

More information will be released soon on the repatriation arrangements.

Meanwhile, the accident site has been closed off for further investigation and all related parties, including DOSH have been informed.
