TRAFFIC ANNOUNCEMENT UPDATES FOR MRT CONSTRUCTION WORKS AT JALAN CHERAS AND BUKIT BINTANG

KUALA LUMPUR, 24 MARCH 2016: MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd (MGKT) wishes to announce short-term road realignment on Jalan Cheras and long-term road realignment on Jalan Bukit Bintang. Details of the realignments are as below:

1. ROAD REALIGNMENT ON JALAN CHERAS

Location	Jalan Cheras (Kajang bound)
Date	29 March 2016 - 30 April 2016
Duration	One month
Reason	Station construction works

The road realignment, involving a 300-metre stretch along Jalan Cheras (Kajang bound) between Cheras district police headquarters and Maluri LRT Station, will be implemented from **29 March 2016 till 30 April 2016.**

During the realignment, the existing three-lane road will be reduced to two lanes. The road realignment is necessary to facilitate station construction works. Please see Map 1 below on the location of the road realignment.


MAP 1: ROAD REALIGNMENT ON JALAN CHERAS

2. LONG-TERM ROAD REALIGNMENT ON JALAN BUKIT BINTANG

Location	Jalan Bukit Bintang and Jalan Sultan Ismail intersection
Date	31 March 2016 – 31 August 2016
Duration	Five months
Reason	Construction of an Underpass

There will be long-term road realignment at the intersection of Jalan Bukit Bintang and Jalan Sultan Ismail which will be implemented **between 31 March 2016 and 31 August 2016.** The realignment is necessary to facilitate the construction of an underpass for the MRT construction works.

During the implementation, the service road in front of McDonald's restaurant will also be closed. Please see Map 2 below on the location of the realignment.
