EMERGENCY ROAD CLOSURE ON JALAN CHAN SOW LIN

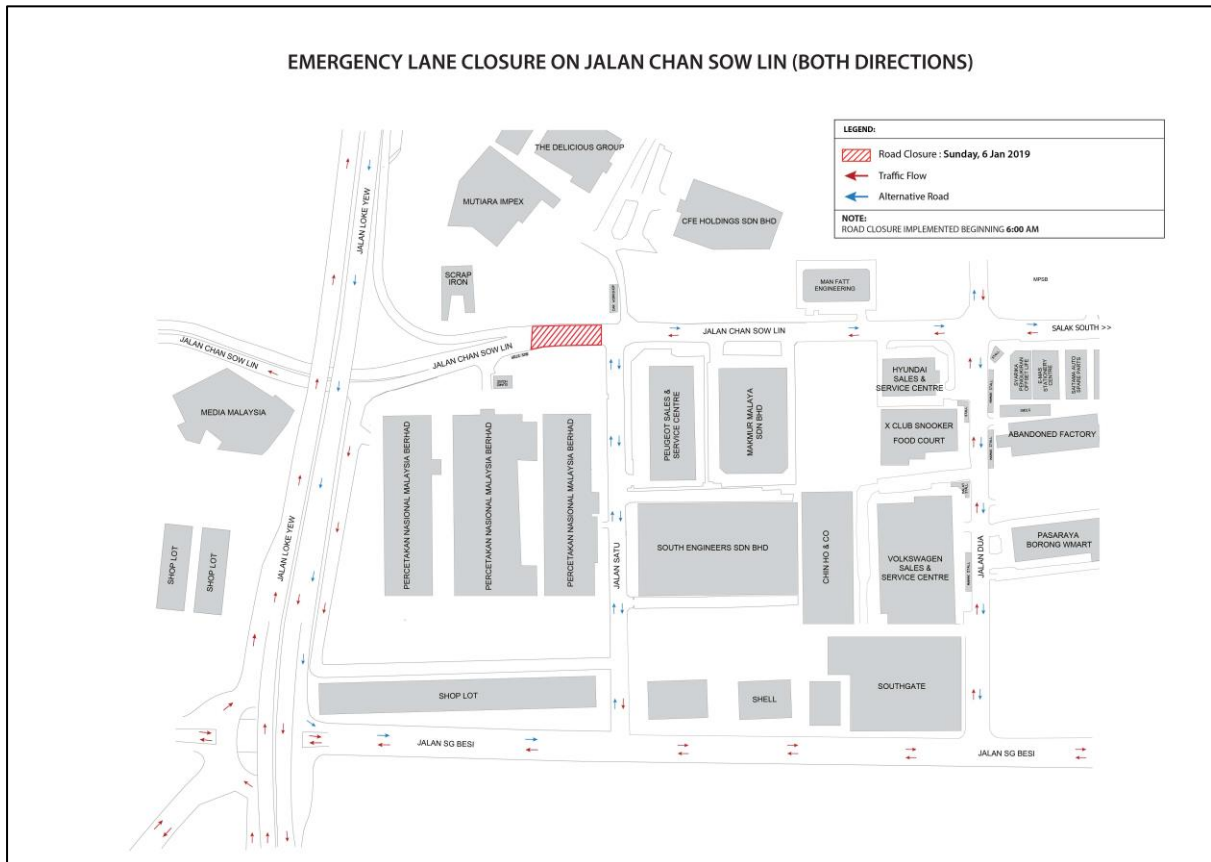

KUALA LUMPUR, 6 JANUARY 2019: MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn. Bhd. wishes to announce emergency road closure on Jalan Chan Sow Lin (both directions).

The closure involving a 50-meter stretch along Jalan Chan Sow Lin near Percetakan Nasional Malaysia Berhad has been implemented since 6:00am on 6 January 2019.

This emergency closure is necessary to facilitate emergency road repair works. Please see the maps below for the location of the closure and list of alternative roads.



ALTERNATIVE ROAD FROM JALAN CHAN SOW LIN TO JALAN PASAR/JALAN CHERAS

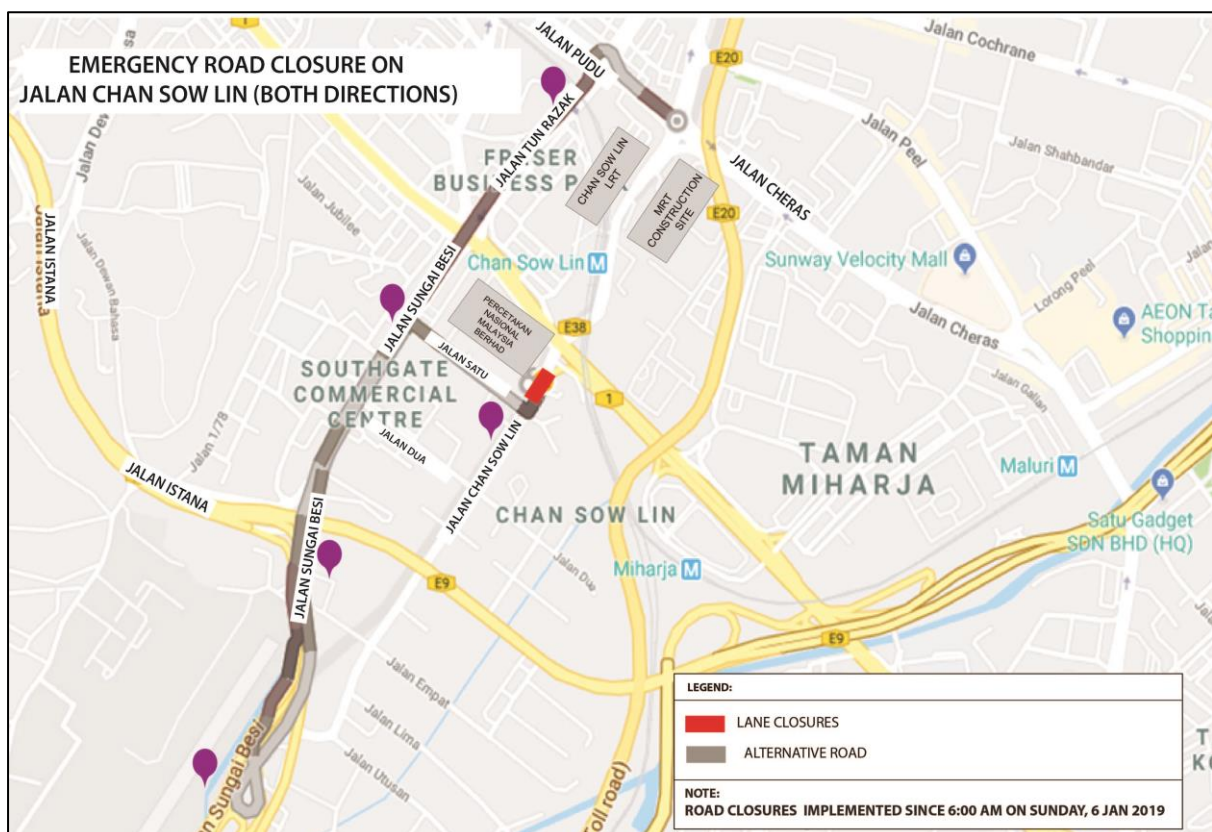
1. Traffic from Jalan Chan Sow Lin heading towards Jalan Pasar/Jalan Cheras are required to turn left onto Jalan Dua or Jalan Satu. Turn left to Jalan Sg. Besi.
2. From there, make a U-Turn which heads towards Jalan Istana but keep right to head towards Jalan Tun Razak.
3. Take the ramp on the left to head towards the Jalan Pudu Roundabout, turn right and take the ramp up to Jalan Cheras or keep left next to the ramp to head towards Jalan Tun Razak/Jalan Pasar.

ALTERNATIVE ROAD FROM JALAN LOKE YEW (FROM CHERAS) TO JALAN CHAN SOW LIN

1. Vehicles from Jalan Loke Yew (from Cheras) will need to head towards the Loke Yew Roundabout and turn left onto Jalan Sg. Besi and left again onto Jalan Satu or Jalan Dua before turning right onto Jalan Chan Sow Lin.

ALTERNATIVE ROAD FROM JALAN TUN RAZAK (NEAR WISMA INDAH) TO JALAN CHAN SOW LIN

1. Vehicles from Jalan Tun Razak (near Wisma Indah) will need to drive up the ramp and turn right towards the Jalan Pudu Roundabout, turn left and drive along Jalan Sg. Besi and then turn left onto Jalan Satu or Jalan Dua before turning right onto Jalan Chan Sow Lin.



Motorists are advised to follow the directional signage and during the closures, the MRT Project Emergency Response Team will be deployed to help direct traffic. MGKT wishes to apologise for the inconvenience caused.
